Thank you for all of your support and for your delightful children who really are a credit to you all. They are all doing so well, making good progress and enjoying their learning. This half term our topic is Our World. We will be covering the following areas...

Understanding the World We will be learning about;

Recycling. How to take care of our world. Wild animals that live in other countries. How to reduce, reuse and recycle. The country Italy and the food, culture and some Italian phrases. How to keep ourselves healthy. The parables stories in the Bible.

<u>Literacy</u>

We will be; Retelling stories. Writing simple sentences about pictures of the world and oceans. Making a poster to remind people to pick up litter. Writing a list of things to do to help to save the world. Writing a pledge of one thing you can do to save the world. Writing a letter to Redusa the Recycling Fairy. Writing about pictures we have drawn in drawing club. Writing Dot and Dan sentences that we have learnt off by heart. Making a passport and tickets for a pretend holiday to Italy.

Mathematics

We will be; Counting up to 20. Recognising and ordering numerals to 20. Revising our number bonds to 10. Learning about capacity. Composing and decomposing shapes.

Creativity

Making something new out of plastic. Making a collage picture using recycled materials. Designing and making a wand from recycled materials. Sketching leaves Wax resist leaf. Water colour painting of The Rainbow Fish

Personal, Social, Emotional Development

Topic – Changing Me Know the names and functions of some parts of the body. Know that we grow from a baby to an adult. Know who to talk to if they feel worried. Know that sharing how they feel can help solve a worry. Know that remembering happy times can help us move on.

Reading

Please ensure that your child's reading books and diaries are in their bag every day in case we want to hear them read.

Please hear your child read for 5 minutes every day. "Practise makes progress."

Please ensure that you write in their diary, so we know how your child is doing at home.
