## YHA Whitby (Mon 13<sup>th</sup> July – Thurs 16<sup>th</sup> July)

- We are excited to launch our new topic of ‘Coasts’ with our residential to Whitby.
- Joining us on the trip will be:

- The accommodation itself consists of a large dining room (with separate toilets), communal spaces for meetings and activities, green spaces to play outside and many en-suite bedrooms (ranging in sizes) spread over 2 floors as well as downstairs toilets.
- The boys and girls will each have their own floor of dorms with staff bedrooms available on each level. The dorms are only accessible via a pre-programmed key card.
- YHA Whitby is only a short walk down to the beach itself – where many of our activities will be taking place.
- All activities will be instructor lead by YHA Whitby staff as part of our Discovery Package.

# Kit lists

## *Clothes to pack:*

Waterproof coat, trousers and sun hat  
Plenty of jumpers/hoodies  
T-shirts (both short and long-sleeved)  
Underwear and socks  
Several pairs of comfortable trousers  
Pyjamas and slippers/indoor shoes  
2 pairs of trainers or walking boots

## *Extras to pack:*

A reusable water bottle  
A small backpack (suitable for day trips)  
A reading book (or 2!)  
Small game to share with friends (Uno, Dobble etc.)  
**Max of £15** spending money (enough for a souvenir, trip to the arcades plus an ice cream at the seaside!)

## *Toiletries to pack:*

Toothbrush and toothpaste  
Face cloth and soap  
Shampoo and shower gel  
Hairbrush/comb  
Towels (one smaller for sandy toes at the beach and one larger for showers)  
Suncream and insect repellent  
Sanitary items (if required)

Please ensure **all items** are clearly **labelled with names**.

In addition, if your child requires any **medication**, including travel sickness tablets, **please make sure it is in a clear, labelled bag** and **given to Mrs Lovett** on the day of departure.

## *Please don't pack:*

Mobile phones/cameras  
Precious/valuable items  
Snacks/food
