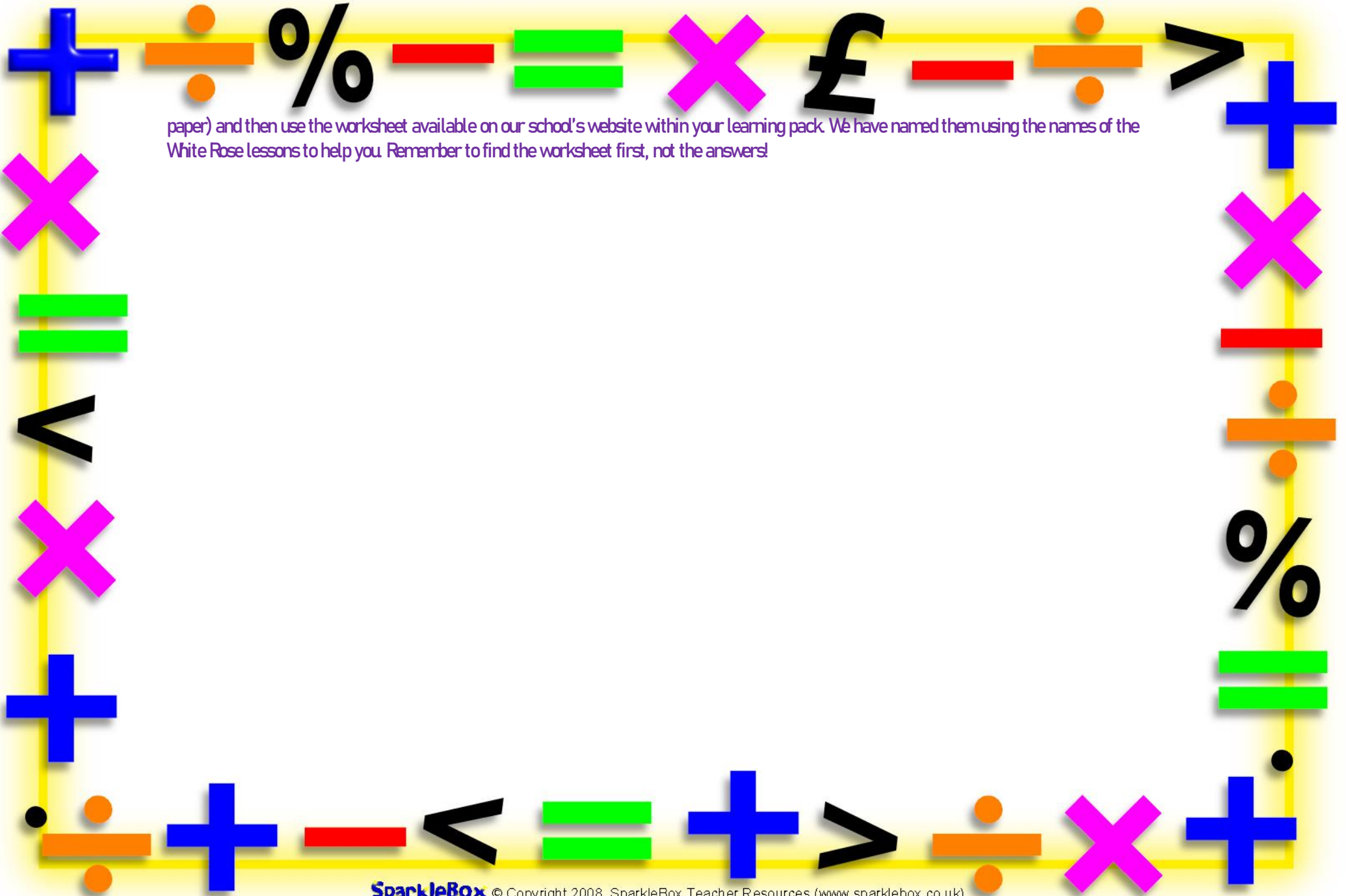


Add these maths activities into your timetable You will need to do the lessons in order, but it's up to you where they fit in your day 😊.
