It will help you to remember how to spell words ending in all!</p> <p>Practise reading, writing and spelling the words on the given sheet.</p>	<p><u>RE</u></p> <p>Read the "Inside the Synagogue" powerpoint and have a go at the task on the last page. You can use the stained glass template saved on the website or use a piece of paper.</p>	<p><u>Reading</u></p> <p>There are 3 short Reading Comprehension tasks to try and 2 sets of differentiated tasks: Marie Curie and Sunflowers. Look at the bottom of the page for level of difficulty and choose the best fit for your child.
