Though a pen and paper will do.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Phonics / Spelling</u></p> <p>We can add the suffix -ment to other root words: pay payment treat treatment We don't have to swap, double or drop any letters when adding the suffix -ment</p> <p>Here is the rule: If a suffix starts with a consonant letter (-ment), it is usually just added straight on to a root word. No changes are made to the root word.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Science</u></p> <p>Last week we explored what plants need to grow. This week, let’s take a closer look at what is in our soil!
