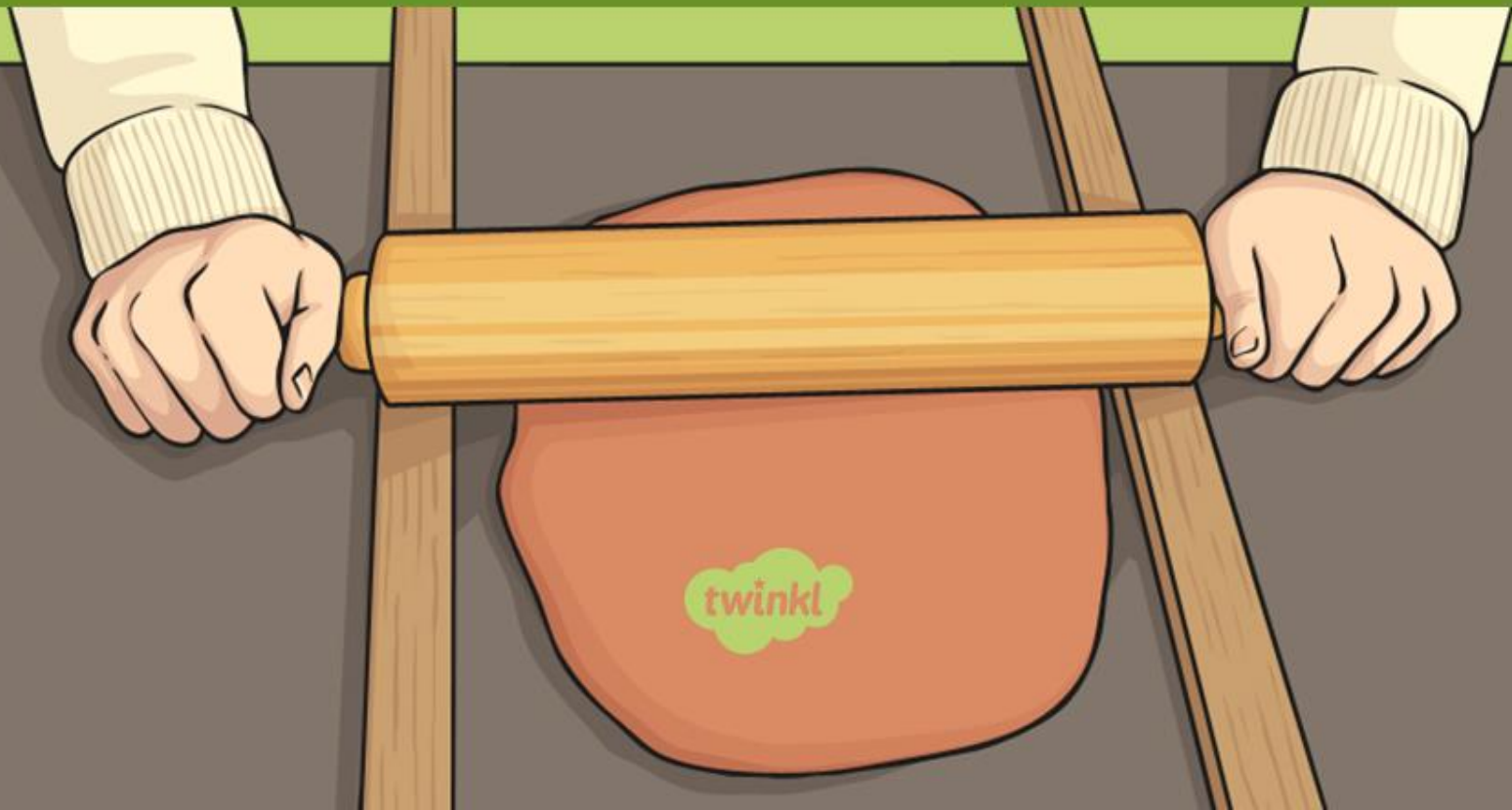

- To think about how a piece of art/sculpture makes them feel.

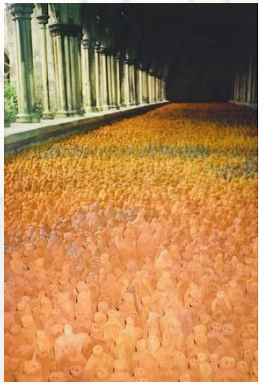
What is a sculpture?

Basically, it's a piece of art, in 3D!

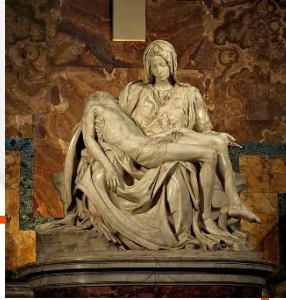

Materials: granite

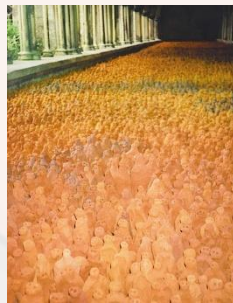


The Traffic Light Tree
